Block Grants	Because departmental funds for fellowships are extremely limited, Block Grant awards tend to be offered to incoming students with unusual promise and to continuing students with good academic promise who are not receiving any other form of university support. Fee Fellowships for Continuing Students	The GGSE is allotted a certain amount of money each academic year to award Fee Fellowships to <b>continuing</b> doctoral, masters and credential students. These funds are limited to use towards payment of in-state fees, health insurance, and/or non-resident tuition, and cannot be given as a stipend. Students must have a current FAFSA on file and have demonstrated financial need as calculated by the UCSB Financial Aid Office. Gevirtz Scholars Dissertation Fellowship	The Gevirtz gift provides dissertation fellowships to assist GGSE students whose career goals are to become leaders as teachers, researchers, or clinical practitioners, and whose dissertation research focuses on the improvement of K-12 education. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The dissertation must focus on issues related to the improvement of K-12 education</li> <li>• The dissertation proposal must be officially approved by Nov. 1</li> </ul> <b>Awards</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Awards may be up to \$5,000</li> <li>• Fellowship awards will be issued as a stipend</li> </ul>	GGSE Student Affairs Office	Early November
Office of the President, Community College Research Assistantship	Open to incoming and continuing doctoral or masters/doctoral domestic in the GGSE who are currently employed in a community college, are on leave from a community college position, and/or are intending to seek employment in community college administration at the completion of their program.
